DROMANA CONSTRUCTION: There is currently a significant amount of construction work behind the current Dromana clinic. This work will be ongoing for quite some time. For the most part there will be minimal disruption to patients, however, for the next 2 weeks there will be no footpath access to the clinic along O'Donohue Street. The temporary fencing also extends across the front of the building.

Private charges and bulk billing arrangements are at the discretion of your treating practitioner.

Fees will be increasing mid August by \$5-\$9 per consultation at the practitioners discretion. Medicare rebates to patients have also increased.

If you are experiencing hardship or have concerns regarding your fees please speak directly with your practitioner.



HAVE YOU HAD YOUR SKIN CHECKED LATELY?

Annual skin checks with an experienced melanographer, dermatologist or trained general practitioner will give you the best chance of catching suspicious spots or moles early when they're most treatable.

South Coast Medical are fortunate to have trained general practitioners specialising in skin checks at the Dromana, Capel Sound and Rye clinics. In addition, the Rye clinic is MoleMap licensed with a trained melanographer on site to provide full body checks with images for comparison in later years.
